Announcement

Loughborough Car Club will organise a National 'B' (and a Clubman's) Sporting Trial on 17th November 2019 The Trial will be held at Eaton Lodge Map ref. SK 790292 this is a short distance west of the village on the unclassified road leading to Stathern and Eastwell. Nearest postcode is NG32 1SW the site is 500m South East of this farm.

Jurisdiction

This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations and by other written instructions that the organisers may issue for the event.

Permits

Motorsport UK Permits have been applied for.

Eligibility

The National B trial is open to all members of Loughborough Car Club, B.T.R.D.A, Northern Phoenix Trials Car Club, Midlands Trials Car Club, 750 MC, Southsea MC, Kentish Border CVMC, Launceston & N Cornwall, Ross & DMC, Cov & Warks CC, Bristol MC, and Midland Automobile Club. Registered competitors in the Motorsport UK Sporting Trial Championship, BTRDA Sporting Trial Championship & BTRDA Allrounders Championship. The Clubman's Trial is open to members of the above clubs.

All entrants to the National B must produce a Competition Licence, Club Membership Card and Championship Registration where appropriate

All entrants to the Clubman's must produce a Club Membership Card

All passengers must be a member of one of the above clubs.

Description of Event

The trial will consist of minimum of three rounds of at least eight sections, conditions permitting.

There will be five National B classes, Red "independent", Red live axle, Blue "independent", Blue live axle and "Rookie". Competitors will be classified according to the BTRDA Formula. A competitor may only compete in one class.

There will be no classes in the Clubman's event.

Awards

National B Trial awards will be presented as follows, subject to a minimum of four starters in the class.

Best Performance in Trial, Driver & Passenger

Best performance by a competitor in Red Class Independent, Driver & Passenger

Best performance by a competitor in Red Class live axle, Driver & Passenger

Best performance by a competitor in Blue class Independent, Driver & Passenger

Best performance by a competitor in Blue class live axle, Driver & Passenger

Best performance by a competitor in "Rookie" class, Driver & Passenger

Clubman's Trial awards will be presented as follows, subject to a minimum of four starters in the event.
Best Performance in Trial, Driver & Passenger

Entries

Entries will not exceed 45 and there will be a minimum entry of 20. Should the above figure not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the event. Double drives will be accepted up to a maximum of 10 entries.
