Proceed to the Paddock entrance and turn Right to Garage 39 to sign on.

Having signed on the test site is in the far left corner go through Gate 1 park as directed.

Conduct: When not on the test please drive slowly, pedestrians may not be paying attention and we wish to remain friends with Donington.

Scrutineering: Car should be presented ready to compete, on the tyres you will use and all loose equipment removed. Bonnet and boot/tailgate already open

Signing On: Remember your club card.

The Tests: There is one test site. You will get three attempts at each test layout, best 2 to count. We plan to run two different layouts. To facilitate this please report for driving and marshalling duties promptly.

Walking the Tests: It is strongly recommended that you walk the tests to familiarise yourself with the route. There will be time to walk each layout in turn. Please arrive in good time so you can walk the first layout.

Marshalling: You will be helping with the marshalling. The Marshalling coordinator will be checking this. Your marshalling session is immediately after your driving session.

Documentation & Results Service: After your three runs go straight to the marshalling coordinator and hand in your time card.

Numbers: These will be supplied and should be affixed to the both sides of the car. Note the colour of these numbers matches the group you belong to (see below).

Entry List and Colour Groups: These are available on both club websites.

Catering & Toilets: Garage 39 will be open, it helps our relationship with the venue if you use this. The toilets will be open.

Trailers: Any Competitor who brings a trailer into the paddock will be taking part in the PCA and not scoring championship points.

The entry has been divided into 4 groups identified by colours, and will follow the sequence overleaf.
