1. The Loughborough Car Club Ltd will organise four evening Clubmen's Production Car Autotests. On Tuesdays 7th & 21st July and 4th & 18th August at Paddy's Lane MR 129/648225.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsports UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FISA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the club may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK Permits will be issued
4. The event is open to: - All fully elected members of the Loughborough Car Club, Mid-Derbyshire MC Coalville Car Club, HRCR, Rugby MC,
5. All competitors and passengers have the relevant club membership card (And if they have one a RS Clubmens Licence)
6. The programme of the meeting will be: - Signing On Before the day. Tests open at 19.00 and close at 21.30
7. Public roads will not be used as link sections. There will be at least 6 tests on private land.
8. Classes: -
The event will consist of three classes as follows: -
Class A Short wheelbase, up to and including 95in. (←
Class B Long wheelbase, over 95 in.
Class C All cars with 4x4 and FWD with an LSD plus anything at the CoC's discretion.-

- All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK technical regulations.
9. **IMPORTANT no "knobbles", Winter, Gravel or M&S tyres.**
The intention is to exclude aggressive tyres which damage the field.
10. There are no Event awards.
Note: Loughborough Car Club runs a Club Championship for full members based upon the four events.
11. The entry list opens on publication. The entry fee is £20.00.
12. Entries Entry forms and driver/passenger declarations must be completed before the event.
WE CANNOT ACCEPT ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected in order of receipt. If there are more than 40 entries reserves will be taken and places allocated in order of entry receipt.
16. Entry fee of £20.00 per event must be transferred to A/c No: 81466852 Sort Code: 40-43-39 Refunds will be in full for any entries withdrawn up to 19.00 on the day of the event. Also full refunds should the event be cancelled.
