

ELIGIBILITY

To score points the championship competitors must be championship members of Loughborough Car Club and have paid the £1.00 registration fee.

Note:- To enter the events drivers must be full members of an invited club, and registering for either championship does not constitute membership of an invited club.

AWARDS.

These will be awarded at the end of the series of events and are awarded separately for the AutoSolo Championship & Junior Championship.

Inter Club Award:- there will be an award for the two clubs contributing events with the best performing members*. At all four rounds the times for the three members* with the lowest total time will be accumulated. These times can come from either event. Competitors' times will be allocated according to the first club they have listed on their entry form.

*who is a full member of Loughborough Car Club or Mid Derbyshire Motor Club and has entered the events as such as well as being registered for the Loughborough CC Championship.

Awards Evening.

COVID permitting there will be an awards evening in the four weeks following the series results being declared final.

POINTS

There are four rounds to the championship. If a competitor competes in all four rounds, then their best three scores will count towards their series total.

Points will be awarded in the Championship with reference to class position in the official results. There will also be extra points based upon class size.

Class position	1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th	7th	8th	9th	etc
Points	25	24	23	22	21	20	19	18	17	etc

In addition, 1 point will be scored for each registered starter beaten in the class up to a maximum of 3 points and one point deducted for each competitor who beats you. There will be no negative points.

i.e. If you finish 1st in a class of six you would have 3 extra points (maximum 3 points) less 0 points as no-one beat you in your class, Totalling 3 points.

If you should finish 2nd in a class of six you would have 3 points less the one that beat you, Totalling 2 points.

But if you were second in a class of three, you would have 1 point less the one that beat you, Totalling 0 points.

The 1st, 2nd & 3rd overall finishers will be awarded a minimum of 28, 26 & 24 points irrespective of the number of entries in their individual class. If the class entered has sufficient entries to make their points score higher than the minimum, then the higher points score will be awarded.

For the overall results points may be scored in different classes.

Junior Driver:- To qualify for the Junior awards the driver must be under 18 of age on 25th November 2020.

SERIES TIE DECIDER:

Clause A. In the event of a tie for position after the four rounds of the series, the highest points score on the first round will take precedence. If this does not resolve the tie, the highest points on the second round will be referred to and so on.

Clause B. If a tie still exists, reference will then be made to the highest combined overall finishing positions on the three scoring rounds of the series.

Clause C. If a tie still exists, the highest overall position in the first round will take precedence.

No competitor may win more than one award other than the Mid Derbyshire / Loughborough Award.
